

**TOWN OF MIDLAND**

**BY-LAW NO. 2927**

A By-Law to prohibit the operation of motorized snow vehicles on any sidewalk or boulevard within the Corporation

**WHEREAS** it has been deemed expedient in the interest of public safety that motorized snow vehicles should not be operated on any sidewalk or boulevard within the Corporation.

**NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MIDLAND ENACTS AND BE IT ENACTED AS FOLLOWS:-**

1. No person shall operate a motorized snow vehicle along any sidewalk or boulevard within The Corporation of the Town of Midland.
2. For the purposes of this By-Law a motorized snow vehicle means a self-propelled vehicle designed to be driven exclusively on snow or ice or both.
3. Any person who contravenes any provision of the by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended. (Amending By-law 98-3)

This By-Law shall come into force and take effect immediately after the final passing hereof.

By-Law read a first, second and third time and finally passed at a meeting of the Municipal Council of the Town of Midland this 8<sup>th</sup> day of December A.D. 1969.
