## **PURCHASING**

The Township was given a Fire Services Grant provided by the Provincial Government in the amount of \$70,000. The intention of the Grant is to supplement fire prevention and protection services for the municipality. Township Council approved the purchase of a Thermal Imaging Camera and Pumper High Volume Hose Connections. The purchase of a Hazard House was also approved in partnership from local Service Clubs, if funds are available, with the balance of the estimated cost to come from the Grant monies.

## **PAVING ON VESPRE VALLEY ROAD**

Township Council approved a contribution of \$3,100.00 toward the Vespra Valley Road improvements south of Snow Valley Road with funding to come from the 2005 approved Roads Operating Budget.

## **PRESENTATION TO AMANDA FOWLER**

On behalf of the Mayor, Deputy Mayor Tony Guergis presented Amanda Fowler with a plaque commemorating her 2004 Ontario Junior Citizen of the Year Award.
