ROAD CLOSURE FOR ELMVALE 2005 SANTA CLAUS PARADE

Council approved following temporary road closures for the Elmvale Santa Claus parade on Sunday, December 4th 2005:

- Queen Street from Simcoe Street to Maria Street, and
- Maria Street from Queen Street to George Street, and
- Peter Street at Maria Street, and
- George Street from the West side of the IGA parking lot to Maria Street
- Simcoe Street from Graham Street north to Queen Street, and
- Simcoe Street south of Graham Street as well as Train Avenue East

CANADA-ONTARIO MUNICIPAL INFRASTRUCTURE FUND (COMRIF) FINAL INTAKE TWO

The Township will make an application for the COMRIF funding for the Hillsdale Water and Sewer project. Hemson Consulting Limited was approved to prepare a business plan in preparation for application at a cost of \$5,000 and Professional Consulting Engineers were approved to prepare an Engineering brief detailing associated costs at an upset of \$6,500.
