- **GRAVEL PRODUCTION TENDER**
Council awarded the 2006 Gravel Production contract to Ken Truax Construction Ltd. in the amount of \$93,494.06 plus GST as per their tender submission of June 20, 2006.

WELL HEAD PROTECTION STUDY

Council will be entering into an agreement as per the terms by the Ontario Ministry of the Environment for the completion of a Well Head Protection Study for Wells # 3 and #4 in the Snow Valley Highlands.

SPRINGWATER OFF ROAD VEHICLE BY-LAW

Township Council passed a bylaw prohibiting motor vehicles, including ATV's and dirt bikes from two unopened road allowances. The prohibition applies to the unopened portions of **Matheson Road and Baseline Road**, east of Apto. The by-law is aimed at reducing the incidence of trespassing, noise complaints, environmental degradation and other conflicts with residential use. Enforcement will be conducted by the OPP and municipal bylaw enforcement personnel. More information is available at www.springwater.ca.

VESPREA DOWNS/DELTREND BACKUP POWER SUPPLIES

Council directed staff to proceed with the detailed design and tender for a new backup generator for the DelTrend Water System and that the existing backup generator at DelTrend be used for the backup power requirements at Vespra Downs.
