TENDERS & PURCHASING

- **GRAVEL PRODUCTION**
Council awarded Ken Truax with the contract for gravel production in the amount of \$97,895.58 plus GST.
- **SURFACE TREATMENT**
Council awarded Miller Paving the contract for providing surface treatment at a cost of \$174,930.00 inclusive of taxes.
- **TOWNSHIP DECALS**
Council authorized the purchase of Township decals from Auto Trim Design for the quoted price of \$6,210.00 plus taxes. The application of decals will be done by Township staff.
- **SIMCOE ST. & TRAIN AVE. RECONSTRUCTION**
Council awarded Arnott Construction Ltd. the contract for the first phase of Simcoe Street and Train Avenue reconstruction as per their tender submitted in the amount of \$361,080.06 and indicated that \$64,093.50 be added to the project from the Elmvale Meadows Phase II developer construction contribution.
- **PAVING OF FIRE STATION #3**
Council authorized Thom Win Construction to complete the 12,187.00 square feet of paving, plus the original paving of base asphalt and the paving works as per MTO's requests at a cost of \$9,903.91 plus GST.

MINESING COMMUNITY CENTRE SEPTIC SYSTEM

The Manager of Recreation Services was directed to pursue the installation of an offsite weeping bed for the Minesing Community Centre and investigate the possible purchase of water conservation fixtures.

SPRINGWATER OFF-ROAD VEHICLE (SORV) WORKING GROUP

Springwater Township Council passed a resolution for a by-law to be brought forward to install stop signs at the intersection of Baseline Road and Rainbow Valley Road East and directed that a further bylaw be brought forward to remove the common right of passage, restrict access, and prohibit motorized vehicles from Old Penetanguishene Road and the unopened portions of Matheson Road and Baseline Road, east of Apto. Council authorized signage, gates and fences to be installed where necessary at access points. Council also received and adopted a set of Criteria for Motorized Trail Consideration.
